## Event Updates

All in-person events, including fighter practices, archery/thrown weapons practices, arts and sciences gatherings, etc., are cancelled for the month of April. As Their Majesties said in their Live from Caid broadcast, no official call has been made on events for May. They are keeping abreast of all the mundane and Society news sources to help make that determination as May gets closer. On a lighter note, Their Majesties will be doing a weekly zoom broadcast on Facebook on Thursday nights. They are also trying to set up a virtual court on April 18.
