Altavia has had a fine reputation in the SCA archer community. More than once, I have heard people say, "What do you put in the water in Altavia that make you all so good?" It makes me proud to be an Altavian. It makes me proud to be an Archer. We have had great opportunities in the past to show how skilled we are. We have won many championships in the past and currently hold many to this day. But the key to continuing our wonderful archery tradition is new archer interest. Without new Altavians picking up the bow, our legacy will die. Generally, new archers have no equipment and like many other martial activities in the SCA, equipment can be expensive. But unlike Heavies, Rapier, and Thrown Weapons, Altavian Archery has no loaner gear, so many would be archers cannot participate in this great sport. Our Captain, Chrtstof, and I, as well as the baronial officers, have been trying to figure out ways of rectifying that problem. We have a meager budget and we are doing a fundraiser to add to it, but we still need help. We need you! We need Altavians to look through their archery equipment and find some they don't use anymore or are willing to part with. We need donations of at least four bows of at least 20 pound pulls, four dozen wooden arrows (in matched groups of at least six), four quivers, six gloves or tabs, and six arm guards. Anything that you can give will be very much appreciated and used. With your help and generosity, we will continue the great tradition of our barony's archers. Thank you for your time.
