Covid Guidelines as of July 1st, 2021

- No masks are required unless the site requires it.
- No attendance cap for events unless the site has one.

- Pre-registration for an event is not required, unless the event requires it, but it's still highly encouraged. People can walk-in to events without pre-registering first, but their contact information must be collected for contact tracing purposes. This pertains to all in-person SCA events, classes, meetings, etc. The contact information gathered must be kept by the Seneschal or Event Steward of the event for six months.

<u>Reminder</u>

All attendees to events (including fighter practices, etc.) must show their signed blue card (or a copy of it but the back with signature also needs to be shown) OR sign a waiver to attend - just like you do at gate when you attend an event.
