ALTAVIA ACRES

If you've resided in Caid for even the shortest while, you're no doubt aware of the Barony of Altavia, one of Caid's loveliest jewels...but have you ever heard of Altavia Acres?

DID YOU KNOW...

Altavia Acres, the Barony of Altavia's Retirement Community, and the invention of Her Grace, the beloved Duchess Bridget Lucia MacKenzie, was founded in 2005, when then Baroness Bridget, and Baron Laertes granted Baron Iain Glic MacRobert and Baroness Theresia diu Theresia diu Harpfærîn a gift of a deed to "one acre of the finest green land and one Manor Cottage within the retirement community of Altavia Acres" upon their stepping down as the Baron and Baroness of Dun Or, "daughter" Barony of Altavia.

In 2008, Baroness Courtney of the White Meadow and Baron Baron Thorin vorðr Ó Séaghdha, during their ascension to the Baronial Thrones at Altavia's 25th Anniversary celebration, presented each of the former Baron and Baronesses present with Deeds to their own retirement homes in Altavia Acres. In October of that same year, Baroness Courtney and Thorin were given the promissory deed to their own Altavia Acres retirement home.

Their Excellencies Baron Secca of Kent, and Baroness Meliora Deverel were awarded their Deed to their Altavia Acres Retirement home in 2014, and Their Excellencies Baron Christofanus and Baroness Cecilia received the deed to their future Altavia Acres residence.

Each Deed stipulates the following conditions: 1) "Subject to Availability 2) "Manor" and "finest" may be subjective in interpretation and 3. Bearer takes responsibility for all taxes, rampaging crusades, natural disasters and occasional whims of the Baron and Baroness of Altavia."


