#### **December 2023 Baronial Council Meeting Minutes**

#### Via Zoom [12/12/2023]

**Attendees:** Sybilla, Tezar, Niko, Amabel, Griff, Merlin, Lynette, Briana MacCabe, Monique, Faolain, Edith, Cirstene, Elle, Damien.

#### **Baronial Comments**

#### Seneschal's Report:

Sybilla has been a wonderful seneschal but has now officially stepped down and turned the office over to Tezar as of Yule. Tezar will be running tonight's meeting.

#### **Old Business:**

**-Yule!** The event was a big success with members of Altavia and Angels, plus guests from baronies and shires near and far. Many members of the barony were recognized with awards on both a baronial and kingdom level.

Niko was the co-steward – do you have a report or just words you want to say?

There were about 70 people going through gate. Not sure all the people who showed up late went through gate as it appeared to be more than 70 people. Clean-up went well, but haven't gotten an official report yet from Fara, but looks like it went alright.

Take-away – The hall was too small! Couldn't do dancing, and the hall had 80 chairs, which were all filled. There were plenty of tables. We didn't end up doing any dancing, and the problem with the plan for dancing was that due to the size of the hall, the plan was to hold off on the dancing until people started to leave and tables could be removed. The problem was, that there were no tables that were completely empties that would have allowed the tables to removed. Didn't feel like there was a lot of down time that would have allowed for dancing either. Final announcements was done really late, so that also didn't allow much time for dancing afterwards. The opening court was also late starting.

NOTE: Cecilia was going to take the toy donation, but left without taking the toys. Baroness Fara ended up taking the toys.

Next year – need to make sure someone assigned to help at gate, but no one was there from Altavia.

Niko thought Elle was going to be there, but forgot to remind her. Lynette took some gate shifts to help out.

**-Garb Donation!** Secca of Kent has reached out to me via email, and he would like donate his garb to the barony. He is moving early next year and has already sold his vehicle, so we will need someone to pick it up from him. – Has this happened? Cecilia offered to pick it up – but it is unknown if it was picked up or not. Griff will check with Cecilia to check on this.

#### **Ongoing Business:**

Awards: Altavia champion favor design contest: There were no submissions. Amabel found some old court & guard favors from previous reigns. She is looking to take those and modify them for the upcoming reign.

#### **New Business:**

Altavia Anniversary – May 11, 2024. I would like to start working on this in January, so just putting it out there that we need to have a steward and a theme for next year's anniversary.

Prep for anniversary. We are going to need more award tokens – only 1 vert fret and none of most of the others. They need to be ordered – last time from Jon-Thom. Usually made by someone in the SCA, haven't had anything mfg previously. Dreiburgen has a company that has made some of theirs, and we could reach out and ask them if needed. They have been made by others in the past, but Jon-Thom has been the one most recently.

Amabel- We have a mold for the pewter bases - if we knew how to color them then she could do the pewter part.

We could check on other possible ways to add the color.

Monique – she pays 30% of the electricity in her home – so she could plug in an electric kiln for doing coloring if needed.

Briana/Niko – Not going to be inexpensive through Jon-Thom or anyone else that makes them. They are durable/not fragile, so there is a cost associated with them.

Amabel – she said there are very few left in the award box, so it looks like we need to order some. Maybe have a separate meeting for the purpose of awards and ordering.

Idea (Niko) for anniversary – having to do with mercenaries. Amabel – they also want to do a ransom tournament, as a part of the anniversary operations.

Briana & Giocchino were interested in being co-stewards.

#### **Officer's Reports**

**Archers** – Cristof: Merlin – There has been archery practices – with approximately 3-4 attendees for practice. There will be no practices this month – cancelled until January.

Related note – Merlin is interested in stepping up as Deputy Captain of Archers. Need to pull up an Agreement to serve.

November 27: 10 fighters with 3 onlookers and one new person. We also had a visitor from Gyldenholt. Cut and Thrust was done as well as teaching.

December 4: 11 fighters with two new people: Jesse and Lia. We also had a returning new person, Forever. Cut and Thrust and teaching was done.

December 11: 11 fighters with a returning new fighter: Jesse. It was a calm night, but teaching and fighting were present.
