SITE RESTRICTIONS/INFORMATION:

- There is no staking into the turf deeper than 6 inches and no driving on turf.
- No amplified music and no alcohol.
- Pets must be leashed at all times and picked up after.
- The park asks that we haul out all of our own trash. Trash bags will be provided.

Marshal, Equestrian – THL Guene Annwyll (Deputy: Vacant):

No active practices currently

Marshal, Rapier – Nikolaus Phaistos (Deputy: Vacant):

There was still a bit of rain this month, but we did have some rapier activity. Altavia was well represented at Red Star War and Summergate Anniversary. Practice is still thriving. We still average ten fighters per week. Rapier teaching is a weekly occurrence. Our Cut and Thrust loaner gear is being used and we have had at least two Altavians authorized. We also had the Baron authorize in rapier. We have also had a few returning new comers, Chandler and Forever. Unfortunately, we still need a couple of loaner daggers to replace our flexies. Discussions are continuing about remedying that situation. Rapier is alive and well.

February 12: 8 fighters. There was both Cut and Thrust and teaching. A brief discussion of the new rules was had. All our loaner daggers are now illegal. Steps are being taken to remedy that.

February 19/February 26: Both were rained out

March 4: 10 fighters with one new person, Chandler, and one returning fighter,

"Forever". Giacchino, plus the usual people, taught; and Cut and Thrust was practiced.

The baronial rapier report has been submitted to Kingdom.

March 11: 9 fighters with Chandler returning as well as Racine. Cut and thrust was done as well as lyric getting authorized in both C&T and longsword.

Marshal, Thrown Weapons – Cecilia Medici (Deputy: Vacant):

Our next practice is the 17th (this Sunday). Altavia needs spears. I need to repair what we have if possible.

I have been asked to fill in as Kingdom TW Marshal until they can find a replacement. I'm scheduled to run Al Sahid on March 30 plus Robin Hood and GWW, so far. Because Cecilia is being asked to step up, we need to look into potentially finding someone else to fill in this position until a Kingdom TW office is found.

Marshal, Equestrian – THL Guene Annwyll (Deputy: Vacant): No active practices currently

Marshal, Rapier – Nikolaus Phaistos (Deputy: Vacant):

This Month has been a bit wet. We had two practices canceled due to the weather. Attendance at the practice we have held is still good. We are averaging about 10 fighters. There has been some wonderful instruction and Cut and Thrust fighting often. Our Baron Griffith authorized for rapier this month. Unfortunately, there has not been any new people for a while though. Our fighters have been apprised of the recent rule changes in Society. One of those changes has affected our loaner gear. All our daggers are no longer legal, so I have been in contact with others in order to remedy that situation. I will keep the barony informed of my progress. We may have to buy at least new dagger blades. Rapier is doing well.
