COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Baroness Tezar of Aeolis

December 2024 Baronial Council Meeting Minutes



Via Zoom Dec 10, 2024: Starting at 6:55 pm and ending at 8 pm

Attendees: Tezar, Griffith, Amabel, Merlin, Lynnette, Tim, Cecilia, Merlin, Saystine, Damien,

Seneschal's Report:

We are moving forward with Consorts champion, which is our only "kingdom" event for the year. I still haven't heard from the kingdom regarding the 2026 calendar year, but I will let you all know when I do. We do have a full slate of officers, although we are looking for deputies for multiple positions. If you know anyone who might be interested in While I am staying on for the year, I am looking for a deputy to take over at Yule next year.

Old Business:

GWW: Don't know the number of hours we had for volunteers as Elle should be the one with that information.

Agincourt (Oct 27th): Don't have the final numbers – Elle should have that information if it is closed.

Ongoing Business:

Yule (Dec 14th): Saystine and Rudolph (Angels).

She has it handled. Everything is set up to go. The main course meat things were settled out. The B&B of Angels are bringing pulled pork and a roast beef. Altavia will bring cranberry meatballs and chicken.

NOTE: See if we can get the cash box from Elle before the site in case she doesn't make it. Merlin will get in touch with Angel's Exchequer to see if she can back up in case there is a problem. We'll need to print out non-member waivers and Lynnette will print up the cash forms.

A last Yule meeting was held on Dec 4th at 7 pm. While the Angels co-steward was invited, he did not make it.

Consorts Champion (Jan 2025): Merlin – Event Steward.

Griff & he did a site walk on Tuesday with the City. It was much easier than dealing with them by e-mail. Al (Asst reg Dir) was there. Have sent him pics of the Dragonwing and Main Pavilion so he can determine if there is a fire permit needed. His initial understanding was that they were very large structures. Hopefully once he sees the pictures he will decide this isn't needed. He is helping with fire permits and trying to work with the city on the cost of the permits, based on the size of the space used. Hopefully it will go smoothly from this point on with permits. Elle has filed for the insurance. He would like to have a meeting next Tuesday (17th @ 7) to talk with the people being there in the morning and helping with set up and to make sure who is bringing. Suzy is already set to bring the pavilion. Kristie will bring and set up signs. We need to coordinate bringing tables and other things. Probably don't need tons, as there is no Auction.

Lynnette – asked about merchants. Merlin - Not in the request so don't think he can have them. There are local merchants who have their insurance who would love to do it.

I, as seneschal, forgot to ask and push for that. In part because there were issues in getting things set up, and in part because it gets dark earlier. For merchants to attend this site, they require 15%

from all sales, in addition to having fire extinguishers, and \$1 mill in insurance coverage. There are 3 merchants that do have that level of coverage. Moving forward, we would like to try to include merchants. Need to add onto the posts that there are no merchants.

Site tokens are set up, doing laser engraved wooden tokens, probably 200-250. Group effort with B&B household.

Caidan Archery Open:

Andrew - board member for the range at Woodley confirmed that 03/16th is open and available. They have put it on the Woodley park schedule. Cecilia with be in Europe, so Paganus is going to be MiC for thrown weapons. Geral is MiC for Archery, along with co-steward for the event with Merlin. I as seneschal need to submit to add this to the 2025 Calendar. Did speak with the Chirons and the archers in the community, and Paul Acker (Chirons Sec & Kingdom) offered to help with the event. Once I get it approved on the calendar we can move forward with the budget and all to get the ad in and get insurance (if needed since it is on a regular practice day). Need to double check with Elle regarding insurance on regular practice days. Merlin will accept any other co-stewards that want to help out. He will talk to some of the newbies.

New Business:

I still have not heard when the 2026 Calendar will be opening so no new news on that front.

We need another Exchequer. Elle had an emergency and was not able to get to Agincourt until more than an hour after it opened. Tim has sent in his paperwork twice to try to find out if he is reauthorized for Exchequer so he can be a backup.

Matlens said she would talk to Giovanni and see if he is willing to take the class and potentially be the deputy. He would be good at it. When is the next class held? Merlin – When he wanted to find a class, it was able to happen as a zoom class by request. It took about an hour. Let me know if he can get it set up as I would like to sit in on that also.

Selene would love to get more active and get the brewers guild more active in the Barony.

Officer's Reports

Archers – Merlin Fojtik (Deputy: Vacant):

We regularly have over 10 Archers at practice. We continue to run the Interkingdom challenge and Seasonal Society challenges. We are working to alternate between challenges and general practices. These appear to be what helps get attendance. We had a new peak high of 5 new archers and 13 total archers November 17th when our practice ended up being moved to later in the day at the last minute. There was apparently a school marathon practice event.

We also helped the range clean up the long range last weekend, including getting our 40 yard target set back up so we can use it.

Very soon we will have three marshals regularly attending practice Cristof, Amabel and myself, with another frequently attending, Gideon

<u>Arts & Sciences</u> – Caterina (Deputy – Marianna Lightwood (Valery Worley)):

We had six attendees for the period culinary night on November 26th, and a nice dinner was had by all. We will have a break from classes for December, due to the holiday season, and then our next A&S class will be pewter coin making at Their Excellencies' house in January. Eleonora has agreed to become Marianna's deputy after she takes over from me at the end of January/early February, and I hope you will all support them both. We have begun a monthly "Fret Fight" boar pit with a different weapons form each month. We have received good feedback on this activity. as I navigate my busy holiday season work schedule. No reports of injury. No reports of equipment or weapon failure. Loaner equipment is serviceable and in good repair.

<u>Marshal, Thrown Weapons</u> – Cecilia Medici (Deputy: Cristof):

Same as Merlin – usually follows Archery. Were there on the 1st not the 17th. Been active. The next practice is Dec 15th. A lot of the archery people will throw after archery practice is done, around noon.

Marshal, Youth Combat – Cecilia di Medici:

Youth - I am not authorized for combat or rapier yet but will work to get authorized soon. No youths fighting right now. Still looking into it. She would really like to get authorized for rapier youth. She would like to for Natalie, who does have the proper equipment.

November 2024 Baronial Council Meeting Minutes

Via Zoom Nov 12, 2024: Starting at 7:10 pm and ending at 8:20 pm.

Attendees: Tezar, Damien, Griffith, Amabel, Merlin, Briana, Giacchino, Kristi (Cirstene), Matlens

Seneschal's Report:

While I am staying on for the year of 2025, I am looking for a deputy to take over at Yule next year.

Old Business:

GWW: B &B It was great to have everybody at GWW, including all those who came by on time and afterwards for the wedding. While the rest of the household wasn't happy about being next to Altavia, she was very happy about it. There were a lot of cancellations, so there was a lot of room, plus overall given a lot of room. Amabel was taking blame, but it is shared with me (Seneschal). A lot of people did step up and volunteer, so the barony got hours. We need to step in sooner to set up a baronial gate shift.

Agincourt (Oct 27th): It happened! Had a lovely event, even though it was after the sadness of Dreiburgen. They did a memorial shut-out for Olaf. Overall, it was a good day, new champions in all areas, a few new people shooting, including their majesties. Both their majesties and Prince Brocc were there. Sven shot a crossbow, Ish her new bow, all did thrown weapons and Brocc did dancing. Had fantastic shooting across the board. One of the new archers – Karen of Altavia – Won the fretted fork. It was the largest number of entries for cooking in a long time. It was a great showing (Cecilia). Cecilia picked the items, then used Cinnamon instead. Christophe and Matlens set up the pairings based on ranking. Everyone really enjoyed the pairings, and people were talking about being happy with this type of pairing as it allowed newer archers to get further. Only 18 people on the list (smaller than normal).

Merlin – Amabel and he became Chiron's, along with a large number of Argent Arrows, including Edric the younger getting one for Thrown weapons.

We need another Exchequer. Elle had an emergency and was not able to get to Agincourt until more than an hour after it opened.

Ongoing Business:

Yule (Dec 14th): Cirstene Fojtik & Faolain – Co-stewards.

The church is secured. She toured it, and it is great. She will put up signs to make sure people get to the right places. I think they are good, although a Yule meeting before it happens would be good. She will need to arrange with people to pick-up things and take them back after the event. Decorating of the head table – will Cecilia be doing it – Yes (Cecilia said) she will. Cirstene just wants to make sure she doesn't have to do it. Amabel has stuff that has been given to her that can be used – will coordinate with Cecilia to determine how they want it decorated. Try to go with the theme.

Briana – It is believed that Sven & Ish will be attending. Not sure based on their calendars. Cecilia will reach out and find out who is going to be there. Cirstene has strips to hang banners with, and there were site tokens found that can be used. Is someone assembling the site tokens? Let's find some help for that work. The hall includes a hall, part of the kitchen, and a room.

Cirstene is pointing out that we should make the other tables nice looking, and maybe bring some extra feast wear so newcomers feel more welcome and included. Really good idea. Cecilia has things planned for kids.

Setting up a final meeting for Dec 4th at 7 pm.

Cecilia – regarding Yule: I spoke to station 60 (near the church) I am to call them day before to see if they'll be able to pick up. It just depends on fires. She will deliver if they cannot pick-up.

Consorts Champion (Jan 2025): Merlin – Event Steward.

He has confirmed the date is available. Still waiting on confirmation of the permit as he has been moved to another person. We are still within time for getting the COI, but it is getting close. The kingdom exchequer is waiting on Elle getting info to him before he can approve. We are getting concerned, but she has indicated that she will get that sent to him. Merlin has an ad written but he needs to wait until it is finalized and the budget approved. He is trying to get everything done as much as possible, so he doesn't have to wait once it is approved. He also needs to reach out to Brocc to determine if he is going to want a Cut/Thrust champion.

New Business:

I still have not heard when the 2026 Calendar will be opening so no new news on that front.

We need another Exchequer. Elle had an emergency and was not able to get to Agincourt until more than an hour after it opened.

Caidan Archery - I've been talking with Geral de Riera, the winner of Caidan Archery Open this year, so he's responsible for making it happen in 2025. The discussion is to hold it at Woodley Park. The currently open date March 16th is the Sunday after Pentathlon which is being hosted in Thousand Oaks. Merlin and Geral are discussing co-hosting it. Need to look at the potential of moving.

Announcement:

"Greetings! As you might have seen, this afternoon we posted a request for commentary on changes to Kingdom Law. One of the changes involves moving both Crown Tournaments and Privy Councils forward one month. This will mean that Spring Privy Council will now be on Sunday, April 6. This is the date Altavia has requested for Robin Hood. This event can technically conflict with Privy Council, but I will point out that all Royals, officers, Their Excellencies and seneschals will be at Privy Council which will impact the event. I recommend considering moving the event to a different date. I will note that Sunday, March 2 will be available since it was the original date for Privy. I have cc'd the Kingdom Scheduler so that you can continue the discussion and let us know what you prefer as a solution. None of this is set in stone until the end of the commentary period and the review by TRMs. However, I wanted to give you enough time to discuss internally and be prepared. Ideally, we are prepared to update the calendar all at once. As always, please do not hesitate to reach out to me if you have any questions or comments."

This was then followed up with this additional email

"Well, actually, I found out that while Altavia hosts Robin Hood, it is put on by Angels. So, I'll be sending out a follow up email looping in Padraic. Caidan Archery Open is not considered an official Kingdom-level sponsored event. The same is true about Caid Rapier Open. It's a floating event sponsored by a local entity (or event as the case with GWW.) Feel free to work with the Kingdom Scheduler to request a new date. If there's no conflict, then she will work the approval process to make it happen. Laertes KSen"

"Greetings! This is an official notice to the territorial seneschals that there is a Request for Commentary to proposed changes to Kingdom Law. Please announce this Request for Commentary at your next business meeting. This notice has also been posted on the Kingdom FB Group, in the process of being posted on the kingdom website and will appear in the December Crown Prints. The following changes to Kingdom Law are proposed by Their Majesties Sven and Iseabail, to take effect upon the Coronation of Their Heirs, Valentine and Brocc. As required in The Boke of Caidan Law (v.19), we are opening a 30-day Request for Commentary process for members of the populace of Caid. The 30-day commentary period will close on December 4. In summary the changes are:

Moving Dates for Crown Tournament

- Bring Existing Ranged Martial Activities Related Awards into Alignment with Upcoming Peerage
- Address Gap in Process for Naming a Regent
- Clarify Language for Determining Baronial Successors
- Codify Royal Peerages and Order of the Rose

Comments on these changes should be sent via email to seneschal.officer@sca-caid.org. All commentary received via email will be presented to Their Majesties and Their Highnesses for Their review upon the closing of the 30-day window. Details on the changes and the wording can be found in the PDF attached to this email.
