Our Baron Griffith was able to make it out to Starkhafn to bid farewell to Thomas and Catylyn and gifted them with a lovely boat to join their Navy for their retirement.

We had a lovely arts and sciences night where we received lots of help creating the belt favors to give to our champions in the upcoming year. Thank you to everyone who came out to help, especially Eleanor and who directed us all in the sewing arts, and Merlin who carved and block printed all of the favors with the design.

We had a few Altavians join the demo at Ridgecon, fighting, interacting with the guests and even joining the costume contest!

We have regularly been running Royal rounds, and getting in IKACs and society seasonal challenges as well. This month, after running 10 archers through the IKAC (Inter-Kingdom Archery Challenge), which is essentially 2 royal rounds + extra speed ends. With these two Royal rounds counting toward each Archer's official scores, we had two archers achieve their next highest rank, with Joseph du Lapia reaching Yeoman and Baroness Amabel reaching Bowmaster.

Society wide, the Order of the Mark was formally established as the Peerage level order for the ranged weapons order, including archery, thrown weapons, combat archery and siege weapons, and kingdoms were granted the opportunity to name three premiers.

What are the William Blackfox awards?

Master William Blackfox was the author and illustrator of the cartoon <u>Warthaven</u>. He gave generously of his time and talents, and was very supportive of the Kingdom Chroniclers until his untimely death.

To honor his memory, the Office of the Society Chronicler sponsors the annual Master William Blackfox Awards to recognize excellence in the work of Chroniclers and newsletter contributors.

How are people nominated for the William Blackfox Awards?

The Kingdom Chroniclers make the initial nominations from the works in their Kingdom. (Kingdom Newsletters and Corporate Publications are not eligible.) All kingdoms are encouraged to participate and send in at least two nominations for each of the categories.

It is important that all participants realize that the nomination of their work is an indication of excellence.

The entries are then separated into the eight categories and the judging is completed by the Society Chronicler, with the assistance of disinterested individuals or experts, where necessary.

In each category, a winner and a Commended entry are chosen. The winners of the William Blackfox Awards, along with those entries recognized as Commended, will be announced each fall, and will appear in the Kingdom newsletters and Tournaments Illuminated. June 2025 Baronial Council Meeting Minutes



Via Zoom June 10, 2025: Starting at 7:06 pm and ending at 8:12 pm

Seneschal's Report:

The Kingdom calendar finally opened up, and we put in our 3 requested events. We received 2 of them, however, are currently working on making a couple switches of dates with our neighbors. They should have the finalized Calendar out this week. Our tentative event are Festival of the Rose on Jan 31 st, and Consorts Champion Ranged on July 19th. This is in addition to our standard Anniversary, Agincourt, and Yule. Caid Archery Open is also on the Calendar although I don't think we are responsible for it (something I can check once the calendar is set).

Please let me know if you or someone you know is interested in Stewarding either of the Kingdom events we were given, especially Festival of the Rose in January. We will need to solidify the location quickly and get the permit processes going. We had spoken about using Tim's Church, so we need to see if this date is available with them, and what the cost would be.

The seneschals report for 2nd quarter was submitted on time (barely).

Old Business:

We have closed out the previous events.

The new pole bag was ordered and has been received. The pictures look great.

Ongoing Business:

<u>Agincourt</u> – Oct 26: Merlin proposes he will work with a new person – Vivienne volunteered – and they will have Ceclia advise but not work it. Held at Woodley. Need to request a COI since it is the 4th Sunday. The only other expense besides the COI is site tokens, and prizes. Prizes tend to get donated, however, we could potentially buy some. Do we want to make it free, but have a donation box for people to chip in for the COI? *Do we want to make it free? Still looking at that yes.*

Vivienne – she has had a couple of enquiries re: feast. Said the same thing Merlin said which is it was something we used to do but isn't currently being done. If someone wants to step up and make that happen, she would joyfully welcome them to do it. The problem is the lack of Niko's church being available. Was \$400 each for Agincourt & yule for use of the whole day, including use of the kitchen.

Griff is checking with the National guard Armory but hasn't heard back from them.

Talking about changing up the format – keeping the spirit, but able to have more shooting for everyone. Working on putting that together, and adding a Novelty shoot in addition to the normal shoot.

Niko – In the past we have had both the championship shoot, plus a clout and/or novelty.

Merlin – Definitely have people interested in doing these different aspects.

Amabel – Definitely encouraging people to come out so they can do more shooting than just the competition.

The Fretted fork event is still an on-going thing, and the winner from last year generally helps run the contest.

Check with Elle and/or Cecilia on if she has a copy of the COI to see what it says. Also, can check with the Seneschal on what the COI will cover.

We could also bring the T-shirts to sell.

Also – if we can't do them at Agincourt – we can always do them at GWW.

<u>Yule 2025:</u> They plan on hosting, and Rudolph has volunteered to be the event steward. We need someone to co-steward. With everything else going on I have not spoken to her further.

New Business:

Waiting on confirmation of calendar before we can fully start planning.

Merlin-something came up from the Capt. of Archers (across the kingdom). Looking for all the baronies to host a Novelty shoot -1 each at GWW and 1 at potrero. Is this something that there would be an appetite for.

2nd related request – The loaner gear that Potrero uses is not owned by the SCA or Calafia. It has been provided by an individual (with a small amount from the college). There has been a small falling out, so there is a question about the baronies being willing to bring their loaner gear to use at Potrero to cover the potential fall-out.

Griff – Thinks it sounds like a doable thing, but something to talk about among the baronies. The biggest issue would be loss of arrows due to the amount of shooting/terrain at Potrero. That could be a cost to be concerned about. How to get arrows cheaply/easily is a conversation to have.

There are 8 active archery communities in the kingdom which would allow for a ½ day for each barony at each war.

Let's look into the cost of replacement loaner equipment that we can anticipate due to breakage and loss. We'll need to do an inventory to see what we have that is useable to loan.

Merlin has looked into some pricing of youth sized arrows. Can get a dozen youth for \$15.

Officer's Reports

Archers – Merlin Wynn (Deputy: Vacant):

We had 2 practices this month. Both were just practice, no challenges or royal rounds. We are shifting our hours to be 9 to noon instead of 10 - 1 due to summer heat. We continue to have good turn out even while hot.

Arts & Sciences – Marianna Lightwood (Deputy: Vacant):

Greetings to all! We held Arts and Sciences Night on May 6th at the home of our Deputy A&S officer Eleonora in Chatsworth. We had our A&S night at our crafting night with a class on Intermediate Brocaded Tablet Weaving. This was a class centered around the uses of supplemental wefts. The class was taught by Rhys an Cairn, and this was a test run of the class he taught at Collegium. This was a smaller class in attendance but still enjoyed by those who attended.

On May 10th, at Altavia Anniversary at Veterans Memorial Park, we held the Arts and Sciences competition to determine our baronial champion. There were about 11 entrants showcasing a variety of types of arts. Our theme this year was Growth, either demonstrated by how far someone has come in their style of art or by showing something that represents growth to that person. Caterina Sanzio was our winner and is our baronial champion, demonstrating her growth in the scribal arts.

A&S Deputy Eleonora will host the last Open Craft Night on June 17th. The Craft Nights will be on hiatus after that. This month, our A&S Night will be Parasol Painting on June 24th. Please see the event on Facebook for more information.

Bardic Jam with the Band of Bards is happening weekly on Monday nights before fighter practice and is hosted by Giacchino. The Band of Bards also performed at Potrero War at three locations: Open Arms, Beggars Inn, and the Sunday Night Bardic Showcase. We are tossing around ideas for future setlists.

Seneschal's Report:

We have received a missive and information (from Privy council) from the Kingdom Seneschals office, which I would like to report here.

From March 21. Greetings. Sharing a note from a recent kingdom Seneschal meetings that may be relevant to members. - If a FB profile has "works at SCA, Inc" or "worked at SCA, Inc." or words to that effect, that is an SCA social media page (even though its an individual's page) and the person opens themself up to potential complaints. One cannot simultaneously say "this is my private page" and have "Works at SCA" in their profile. — Sir Philip, Caid Kingdom Seneschal

From Privy council -

The kingdom recently deployed a Kingdom-wide Discord server. The office is working on developing a "proof of concept" to digitize Warrants and Waivers. The Seneschal's office is continuing work on the membership map that was started by Master Laertes. They are also working to deploy a tool to allow Kingdom seneschals to look-up/track membership.

They are also working on updating the kingdom calendar and scheduling process. NOTE: The reason we have not yet been able to bid on any 2026 events is they have not finalized the 2026 calendar. Until that is done, bidding can not be started.

No formal announcement regarding the new peerage, however, it is "guessed" that is should happen during the next reign. We can not make any hard plans until the BOD confirms a date and the completed paperwork.

There have been weekly Corporate Earl Marshal meetings to complete a new Society-wide Armoured Combat book. This will be in a more search accessible format, with society rules overlayed with kingdom level to cover those areas that are different. Once this is complete, it will be done for Rapier, Cut & Thrust, archery, and TW also.

Just before each coronation, the EM requires all territorial marshallate officers to re-sign their Agreement to serve, which is then signed by the new monarchs. The EM is trying to crack down on this, which is why he has been asking for the names of the marshallate officers from each territory. He is also trying to make sure that all territorial marshallate officers are sending in their quarterly reports, in compliance with corporate rules.

NOTE: All practices must have a Marshal-in-charge who is authorized in the forms being practiced; and an armor inspection; before practice may start.

On a positive note – CAID's policies on talking through and handling issues on the field has been so successful that other kingdoms are asking for what we are doing right, to be used as an example of what to do.

A&S - Pentathlon used a digital platform for registration and judging. If you have any thoughts on this, please let me know as they are taking feedback to evaluate the system. They are also asking for feedback on having classes as a part of the event, which seems to have been a success. As a part of this – the event only lost \$500 compared to the several thousands it normally loses.

Exchequers – Kingdom will be working primarily on discord.

Chronicler – The Society level officer is currently updating the handbook. They are also asking that all chronicler items be sent to the archivists in addition to their office moving forward.

IT – they are updating the system technologies. Discord is up. By the end of the year NO official business is allowed to go through non-official addresses. If you don't have an official address and need one- ask and it shall be provided. As a part of this – all territorial sites MUST be through the official Kingdom site meaning the one that has places.sca-caid.org as a part of the URL

Chatelaine – Looking to add a quarterly newcomers meeting on zoom. She will also be doing another Newcomers track at GWW – so let your people know. She is also working on a template for Chatelaine cards, but doesn't have it done yet. She asked the question "what is our baronies yearly demo?"

GWW – They are not raising the fees for this year. However, they are asking that everyone register as early as possible (once it is up). They need to get the numbers up to continue holding the event. Also, they are asking if there are any baronies or households with large pavilions that might be available to use at various locations around the site. Looking to reduce the rental costs if possible.

Social Media – The Discord is up and is easier to spread event information on. There are 5 moderates constantly checking to monitor content. Please make use of notification buttons if you see any issues.
