At Crown, we had a full day of peerage offers, awards, arts, snow cones and enough fighting to tire even the most energetic and high stamina fighters.

The fighting throughout the day was a joy to watch, and both Sir Christian and Duke Willhelm fought magnificently in finals. At the conclusion of an epic day of fighting we were able to welcome Duke Wilhelm and Countess Lorissa as our new Prince and Princess of CAID.

We're looking forward to the next month, including a brand new camping event this weekend, Fire and Ice, which is focusing on ranged weapons, as well as our own archery championship, Agincourt, and Great Western War following closely behind.

Agincourt – Oct 26

Vivienne & Merlin are stewarding. V – Pretty much set – As long as everyone who promised anything is still handling those things.

Merlin is handling Crossbow, will not be competing, only stewarding. Karen is doing Fretted Fork, Cecilia is doing Youth Project. Bjorn will be there, as Roisin is in Hawaii. Highnesses will not. Tezar is providing food for Majesties.

GWW

Peter is the camp master and has requested the normal location. There is a Baronial camp site and at least 8 people have registered with the Barony. Some of the Flaxen Abbey have registered to camp with the barony.

Peter held a 7 pm meet up on Zoom to go over things that help when camping at a war. There were several newer people and a couple of experienced people (me included). I felt it went well.

Angels is hosting and they have a site, the Santa Anita Church hall, located at 226 Colorado Blvd, Arcadia, CA 91007. Mistress Fara and Rudolph are working with the church. Cecilia is our co-steward. The theme will be: What does Yule mean to you? Decorate in a way that denotes what Yule means to you, such as Xmas trees & presents, a yule log and harvest wreath, or whatever else might represent Yule.

Festival of the Rose - January 31, 2026

It will be at The Santa Anita Church in Arcadia, CA. Parking will be at the back of the hall. Look for signs guiding you to parking and the event hall.

Contests will include, but may not be limited to:

- Angels/Altavia Bardic Champion (participants may declare for either or both baronies.) Bardic entrants, please limit your performance to no longer than 4 minutes.
- Chess Champion for Angels/Altavia. The competition will be run by last year's Champions.
- Best Table Setting.
